

# correction dose

This is the insulin dose you take for high blood glucose during the day and at bedtime.

**Meal time:** 0.5 unit per 50mg/dL over 200

**Bedtime:** 0.5 unit per 50mg/dL over 250

blood glucose	daytime	bedtime
Under 201	0	0
201-250	0.5	0
251-300	1	0.5
301-350	1.5	1
351-400	2	1.5
401-450	2.5	2
451-500	3	2.5
501-550	3.5	3
551-600	4	3.5
Over 600	4.5	4

Only give correction dose if it has been **more than 2-3 hours** since the last dose of fast-acting insulin.
